COMMENT

Popp – Congratulated Boys and Girls Basketball and Cheer Team and encourage residents to get out and enjoy the nice weather.

Bublioni – Congratulated the local sports programs and discussed the LED street lighting installed in the township. Would like to see the city wait on buying lighting until the hydro facility is cleared on repairs. Also, questioned if the money has been received from the MI-Rec's. Discussed street patching, and expressed his disappointment with the last plow job, (salting and sanding while it was melting) was a bad judgment call. Also, questioned why we are not using a WWTP employee working on the weekend for plowing. Suggested lifting the parking ban (if weather continues), and glad trees are being cut. Looked at list of streets that need to be fixed as part of the RD project, and reminded staff to contact the Road Commission about sinking manholes. Also, asked City Manager to explain the increase in City millage rates that was in the newspaper.

Meneghini – Talked about the newspaper article addressing increases in property taxes. Also, shared positive information collected from Police Chief Shafer, regarding time spent at local gas stations and convenient stores.
