- PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE City Mayor Brew led the Council and the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.
- ROLL CALL Members present were: Brew, Kraemer, Muraro, and Popp
- ALSO PRESENT Ray Anderson, City Manager; Grant Carlson, City Attorney; Trisha Plante, City Clerk; Mary Pollard, City Treasurer; Jeremy Oja, Norway City Council applicant; and no (0) citizens present.
- APPROVE 20-273 AGENDA A motion was made by Council Member Popp, supported by Council Member Muraro and unanimously approved regular meeting agenda for November 16, 2020.
- APPROVE 20-274 MINUTES A motion was made by Council Member Muraro, supported by Council Member Popp and unanimously approved Regular Meeting Minutes of November 2, 2020 as amended;
- 20-267 A motion was made by Council Member Kraemer, supported by Council Member Brew and approved to not amending marijuana ordinance.

- APPROVE 20-275 MANIFEST A motion was made by Council Member Muraro, supported by Council Member Popp and unanimously approved manifest 2020-22 in the amount of \$2,105,520.84.

- APPROVE 20-276 APPOINTMENT COUNCIL MEMBER OJA A motion was made by Council Member Popp, supported by Council Member Kraemer and unanimously approved the appointment of Jeremy Oja as Council Member with a term expiring in November 2021
- City Mayor Brew welcomed Council Member Oja, and City Clerk Plante gave the Oath of Office.

- DISCUSSION Council discussed Resolution 2020-21 Vacate Public Right of Way – Beverly’s 1st Addition. Council agreed to postpone action on vacating until a definite plan for an alternative route is established.
- Council discussed Legal Marijuana Ordinance Amendment – It was agreed to bring back December 7, 2020
- APPROVE 20-277 A motion was made by Council Member Muraro, supported by Council Member LOCAL ROAD Oja and unanimously approved Bacco Construction for change order #3 on the PROJECT CO#3 2020 local paving project for a change order price not to exceed \$8,178.26 and total project cost not to exceed \$944,451.26.
- APPROVE 20-278 A motion was made by Council Member Kraemer, supported by Council Member LOCAL ROAD Popp and unanimously approved Bacco Construction for final pay request #2 for a PROJECT PAY REQUEST #2 payment of \$67,237.17.
