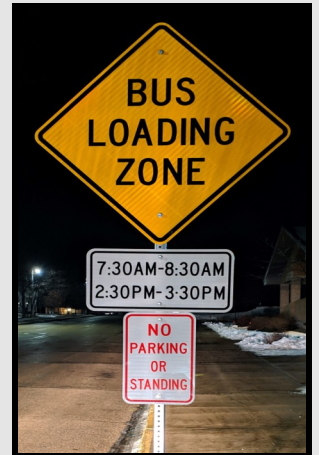

NOTICE—Traffic Control Order

Traffic Control Order TC18-03 was approved October 15th by the Norway City Council. This traffic control order is to establish a bus loading and unloading zone on the South side of 4th Ave. adjacent to the school property. This bus parking zone will be from the first crosswalk on 4th Ave. from the East side of Section St., to the 3rd crosswalk on 4th Ave.

The bus loading zone was created to prevent congestion during the times that the school busses are picking up students. As the signs clearly indicate there is to be no parking or standing during the identified bus loading times which is 7:30am to 8:30am and 2:30pm to 3:30pm. Standing by definition includes stopping, which is currently happening when you stop to pick up your child. You are NOT allowed to enter the bus loading zone during the prescribed times even if your child is waiting on the curb for you. The rule was established at the request of the bus drivers because of the congestion.

They must have clear and uninhibited access for both the safety of the children and the general public. To this point, officers have been giving warnings. However, after school break tickets will be issued if we cannot get compliance. Please be courteous toward our bus drivers and the students loading and unloading for school.

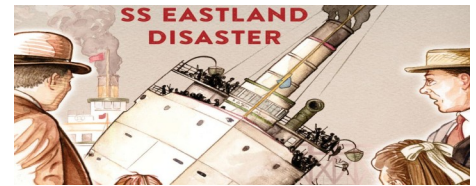

Council Meetings Televised!

By Charter winter taxes are due by the 15th of February each year. The Norway City Council has traditionally extended the due date to the end of February. We again anticipate this will happen.

After 5pm Television, Internet, Phone Service Calls

For television related issues, such as channel outages, sound issues, or TV guide please contact the city hall at 563-9961 and listen to the menu. There is an automated feature which sends your voicemail directly to the technicians cell phone. This helps improve our customer support by getting a quicker response and providing documentation for maintenance.

Non-Emergency Phone Calls

For after hour calls, and utility outages call city hall at 563-9961 and select the proper department (*electric, water, sewer, etc*). A message is sent to department that is needed to take the call. If you have a police issue and need an officer immediately (*not utility/streets issue*) call dispatch at 774-6262 and they will dispatch accordingly. If you do not need an officer immediately and just want to leave them a message you can call 563-5801. An officer will return your call when they become available.
When you call City Hall after business hours, listen carefully to the message and respond appropriately.
