Snow Removal and Street/Alley Obstructions

Every year we notify or alert residents about winter parking ban or rules. The rules are in place to provide the DPW plow drivers clear access so we can plow our streets and alleys and avoid obstructions. This is for your safety and the safety of our drivers. Please remove any obstructions from these areas such as portable basketball hoops. Over the past number of years these types of items have become more popular and more of a problem. If we notice any obstructions we may be sending out letters to remind you to remove these items. Thank you in advance for helping us by allowing clear access to clean your streets and alleys.

LEAF PICK-UP



Every fall the city comes by and does a leaf pick-up from the boulevards. Leaf pick-up started the last week of October. Traditionally, the crew works from one end of town to the other and will rotate back as time permits. The City **DOES NOT** pick up brush.

Please continue to take your brush to the compost site located near the golf course on Oak Crest Drive.

The City will be picking up leaves that are piled on the Boulevard.

Please DO NOT rake the leaves into the street. Per City ordinance #410, No person shall sweep or cause to be swept any dirt or litter of any kind or type whatsoever out of or off of any building or private property and into any public, sidewalk, parkway, alley or roadway of the city.
