## Join us for our 4th of July Celebration, Parade, Music & Fireworks

The Norway City Band will be performing a concert at the band shell located next to the City Hall prior to the Norway Volunteer Fire Department's fireworks display at dusk.



## FIREWORKS REGULATIONS

No person shall ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks within the city, except this prohibition shall not preclude any person from the ignition, discharge and use of consumer fireworks after 11 am on the following days consistent with Sec. 7 (2) of Public Act 256 of 2011 as amended:

- A. December 31 until 1 am on January 1
- B. The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days
- C. June 29 to July 4 until 11:45 pm
- D. July 5, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 pm
- E. The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days

Pursuant to PA 256 of 2011 the penalty of violating ordinance shall be a civil fine of \$1,000.00 for each violation of the ordinance and no other fine or sanction. A remittance of \$500.00 of the fine collected under this ordinance shall go to the City of Norway Police Department.

A person shall not ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks on public property, school property, church property, or the property of another person without that organization's or person's express permission to use those fireworks on those premises.

## DOG RULES (ORDINANCE #391)

Every year, especially around this time, we receive numerous complaints regarding loose dogs and dog defecation in public places. Many of our complaints come at Strawberry Lake where dog owners allow their dogs to run off leash. We also see defecation piles not only at the park but along Main Street. Per Ordinance #391, dogs must be on a leash or in a fence. They cannot run at large. Also, a shock collar does not constitute in control. You must have them on a maximum 6 foot leash. So with this being said, your dog must be on a leash when you walk them in the public such as Strawberry Lake, Hanbury Lake, the Norway Myr, or Marion Park. You may have a wonderful, friendly dog that loves everyone or any other dog. I may not and if your dog runs up to meet mine and my dog attacks yours (while on a leash), I would feel bad but not responsible since your dog is loose. Also per ordinance #391, you must pick up after your dog if it defecates on public property. This includes sidewalks, boulevards, parks, or any other public place. The ordinance also states that while walking your dog, you are supposed to have a baggie or other means of disposing the defecation. Please follow the rules. Leash your dog in public and pick up after them.

## DONATING “STUFF” INSTEAD OF THE DUMPSTER

Each year we go through the annual ritual of the city garage sale to clean out our house of “stuff” that we no longer need. Following the sale we typically load up our “stuff” and head to Goodwill or St. Vincent DePaul to donate. Unfortunately St. Vincent in Norway is overburdened with “stuff” that they are not taking donations. The St. Vincent in Iron Mountain is accepting donations on Tuesday’s and Wednesday’s from 10 am to 2 pm and on Saturday’s from 9 am to 1 pm. We would like to provide you some other options to get rid of “stuff” especially considering that now all we want to do is donate. Please give these types of options a try before just dumping in the dumpster especially considering the numerous families that could use your “stuff”.
