

## Ordinance No. 436

An ordinance to amend and update Ordinance 371, Section 7, of November 7, 2005 Norway Code of Ordinances.

### THE CITY OF NORWAY ORDAINS:

**Article I:** The City of Norway Ordains that the Norway code of ordinances, Chapter 26, Article II, Section 26-37- Rubbish Collection, shall read:

#### **Section 26-37 Rubbish, Recycling, and Compost:**

- a) Rubbish: The City shall provide a supplemental rubbish collection or drop-off location. The City may establish appropriate rules and regulations, to be, from time to time, enacted by the city council by a simple majority vote, as to the nature and type of rubbish to be dropped-off, the time periods of drop-off, and manner of preparation of said rubbish in preparation for drop-off. Use of supplemental rubbish collection containers shall be limited to City of Norway residents only. Commercial or for-profit use shall be strictly prohibited. No hazardous materials, building materials, tires, or batteries may be deposited in the rubbish collection or drop-off location. A request for assistance may be submitted to city hall for rubbish, refuse, or yard waste collection. Said request shall be subject to an established fee structure and personnel availability.
- b) Recycling: The City shall provide a recycling drop-off location. The City may establish appropriate rules and regulations, to be, from time to time, enacted by the city council by a simple majority vote, as to the nature and type of products to be accepted for recycling, the time periods of drop-off, and manner of preparation of said recycling in preparation for drop-off. Use of the recycling containers shall be limited to City of Norway residents only. Commercial or for-profit use shall be strictly prohibited. Recycling bins shall only accept recyclable materials, to wit: #1 and #2 plastic, metal cans, non-corrugated paper.
- c) Compost. The City will provide a location (compost collection facility) for residents of the City of Norway and Norway Township to deposit yard waste and compostable material (i.e.- grass clippings and leaves). An area will also be made available to deposit brush.
  - a. The City will establish appropriate rules and regulations, to be, from time to time, enacted by the city council by a simple majority vote, including but not limited to: the nature, type, dimensions, and character of yard waste and compostable material accepted, operating hours, as well as any additional operational conditions that may be imposed at the discretion of the Norway city council.

- b. The compost collection facility shall not be utilized by commercial or for-profit entities. Deposit of rubbish, yard waste, or brush by commercial or for-profit entities is strictly prohibited. Deposit of brush over 2' in diameter and non-compostable material is strictly prohibited.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This ordinance shall become effective no earlier than 15 days after enactment nor before publication thereof, as set forth in the city charter.
