

## ORDINANCE NO. 437

### AN ORDINANCE ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE

An ORDINANCE to AFFIRM an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the City of Norway located in DICKINSON COUNTY, and to designate regulated flood hazard area under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

The CITY of Norway ordains:

**Section 12-2. AGENCY DESIGNATED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Dickinson County Construction Code Commission of the County of Dickinson is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the City of Norway under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The County of Dickinson assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the City of Norway.

**Section 12-3. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended and pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement between the City of Norway and County of Dickinson regarding the floodplain management regulations as contained in the state construction code, including Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code, shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the City of Norway.

**Section 12-4. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS.** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) entitled "Dickinson County, Michigan (All Jurisdictions)" and dated December 04, 2012 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map(s) (FIRMS) panel number(s) of 26043C045OC dated December 04, 2012 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the "Flood Hazards" section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code.

**Section 12-5. REPEALS.** All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 12-6. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be effective 21 days after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall become effective no earlier than 15 days after enactment nor before publication thereof, as set forth in the city charter.


