

ORDINANCE NO. 442

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE #399 OF 2012, AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND USE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWAY

THE CITY OF NORWAY ORDAINS:

Prohibition on use of consumer fireworks.

No person shall ignite, discharge or use consumer fireworks within the city, except this prohibition shall not preclude any person from the ignition, discharge and use of consumer fireworks after 11 am on the following days consistent with Sec. 7 (2) of Public Act 256 of 2011 as amended:

- a) December 31 until 1 am on January 1
- b) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days
- c) June 29 to July 4 until 11:45 pm
- d) July 5, if that date is a Friday or Saturday, until 11:45 pm
- e) The Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day until 11:45 pm on each of those days

Pursuant to PA 256 of 2011 the penalty of violating ordinance shall be a civil fine of \$1,000.00 for each violation of the ordinance and no other fine or sanction. A remittance of \$500.00 of the fine collected under this ordinance shall go to the City of Norway Police Department.

A person shall not ignite, discharge, or use consumer fireworks on public property, school property, church property, or the property of another person without that organization's or person's express permission to use those fireworks on those premises.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This ordinance shall become effective no earlier than 15 days after enactment nor before publication thereof, as set forth in the city charter.
