OLD BUSINESS Project Updates:

Strawberry Lake Project – The committee began discussions with the Strawberry Lake irrigation project. Beck’s Ornamental and Turf can start project anytime. The electricity is also needed at Strawberry Lake softball field for the irrigation, pitching machine, and lights.

Norway Myr – No update.

Hanbury Lake (beach restoration) Update/actions – Continued discussion on the geese problem at the beach. Suggestions were made, such as spraying the grass and a coyote decoy, to help keep geese away.

Mountain Bike Trails (single track) Update – Phase 1 is open, and phase 2 should be open in the spring. Also, discussed issues with hunting blinds and the safety of bikers along the trail. The decking along the trail will be done in the spring.

Marion Park (Softball, parking lot) Update – The snowmobile trail has been rerouted and city employees will be removing stumps at the new softball field. The donation plaque and rock placement has been decided at the tennis courts and will be placed this fall. Also discussed Boy Scout building maintenance and Stromquist gave an update on the basketball courts.

Urban Forestry Plan Update – No update.

Main Street Pocket Parks (US2/Main Street & Veterans Park) – Discussed new drawings that are needed for the Pocket Park and Veterans Park. Also, discussed having a mural placed on the building (American Legion) next to the Veterans Park.

Menominee River State Park – Parks & Recreation Committee discussed Northwoods moving to the end of the Piers Gorge Road.


